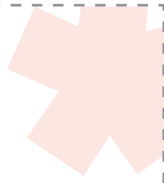
This means that a person is not physically attracted to other people.



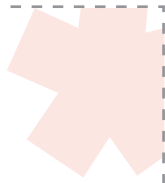
This means a woman is into women.



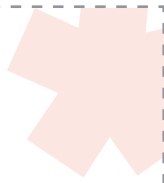
This means a man is into men.
